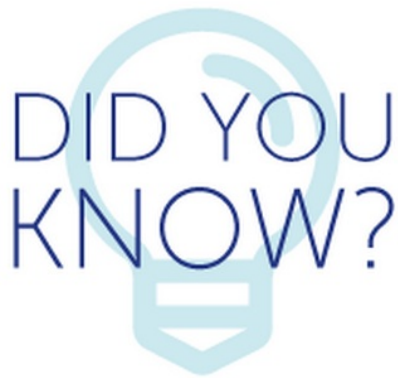
Students Can't Wait: ESSA Resources from the Education Trust
